Cllr Nolan commented that a kingfisher lives next to the Elder tree. Cllr Wittam added that the kingfisher uses the tree and that if the tree goes that the kingfisher will likely go too. He further stated that in his opinion the area has been devastated and we should ask for a Tree Preservation Order for the tree. Cllr Wittam commented that any screening that was there for the residents opposite the hotel has been removed and they will now be blinded by the light show that has been installed. Cllr Brocklehurst agreed that we should recommend a Tree Preservation Order be put on the Elder tree.

Cllr Lukaniuk commented that we should take people's concerns on board and stated that he was against the application and that the tree should remain. A vote ensued.
